

HOW TO START A NEW ROUND

- Click the NEW ROUND tab on the main menu
- Under the select a course heading click SEARCH or if you have a home course/regular round just tap recent and it will bring up the most recent courses you have played
- Type in the full name and correct spelling of the course you are playing then hit search in the bottom right corner
- When you see your course touch it which will bring you to the Select a Tee screen
- Chose which Tees you will be playing from and that will bring you to the Select Players screen
- Either create new players & their handicaps or pick from the ones you currently have by touching their names until you see a check mark
- Then click Begin Round which will bring up the scorecard displaying the appropriate dots where each player will receive strokes off the lowest handicap

HOW TO USE THE SCORECARD

- To view the hole yardage and handicap touch the number hole you desire on the green bar across the top of the scorecard to see the drop down display
- To enter a score simply touch the cell next to the golfers name you want to enter the score for and a number panel below will pop up to enter score then touch OK to make the number panel go away
- The scorecard will show the first nine holes and to see more just slide your finger to the left
- Menu in the lower right will give you options to Email the scorecard, open Paypal to distribute money & a link to GHIN to post your handicap

HOW TO ADD A GAME

- When first starting a new round and you are in the scorecard screen...touch ADD GAME prior to teeing off
- This will bring up a list of wagering games to choose from...choose your game
- In the following screen configure your game according to the touch screen instruction and place a bet value for that particular game and the players involved(just touch the players name so you see a check mark). Then hit done to return back to the scorecard
- Some games will have multiple options in which you would touch the options button to pick auto press for example
- If your game requires teams just select the teams button and touch each player for team one and team two.....hit done when finished
- Your game will show up at the bottom of the scorecard in the red column

- After entering a score for each player on a hole the app will display in the red cell who or what team has won that hole.
- For a breakdown of each hole touch the red cell which will bring up a pop up screen displaying details of the bet for that hole and where you stand
- You can add as many games as you want and it will automatically calculate the wagers for you

SCORE MODE & MONEY MODE

- On the scorecard screen you will see score mode and money mode button in the bottom center .. this will enable you to switch back and forth from the tradition scorecard and the money scorecard displaying the breakdown of each hole
- MONEY MODE – this area will display what each person has won or lost in total according to how many games they are playing
- You can touch each cell in money mode to get a better understanding of why you won or lost that amount and for which game
- At the end of your round it will provide you a total of all games of what you owe or have won to be distributed to the other members of your round
- When emailing your card it will send a traditional scorecard view as well as a money scorecard view for everyone to enjoy

RESUME ROUND

- Resume a Round tab is exactly that...if you want to resume a round you are currently in just tap the button and pick up where you left off.
- This might be necessary if you had a phone call, were using your phone for other reasons like searches.
- Once you find the course you would like to resume just tap it and you a good to continue your round without interruption or the need to enter any info again
- To delete a round just swipe your finger on the screen to the right then touch delete

COURSES

- You would hit the courses tab to search for a course in our database in which we have every USGA registered course in the United States, roughly 18,000
- Search the course you would like to find out information on and once it has been displayed simply tap it
- The next screen will be course details where you will find The name, classification, designer, how many holes & the year built

EDITING A COURSE

- Under the courses tab and after you choose your course you will see an edit button in the bottom right
- You would use this edit button to adjust yardage, hole par, hole handicap or tees due to renovations not yet recorded or if your course is not USGA registered.
- Once you edit the course it will be saved so you never have to enter the information again

GAME RULES

- Under the game rules tab you will find the instructions on how to play each game that Golfmoolah has to offer.
- It will give a step by step example on how the math for that game works, the best number of players to use and format being team or individual
- Simply scroll up or down to see full text

PLAYERS

- When you hit the players button that will bring you to a screen where you can enter the players you are playing with or to just keep a list of people you want always available
- To create a new player tab "create a New Player" and then enter their name and handicap which will both be recorded and saved in the application for ease of use when starting a new round
- Click save and then those players have been stored in your list for future use
- To delete a player just swipe your finger on the screen to the right and then touch delete

- Under the more tab you will find a link to the Golfmoolah website that will provide some more in depth information about the app and how to download it from iTunes
- Tell a Friend link will allow you to email a link to your friends letting them know you are using this great app and think they should download it as well...this will have a link for them to do so which is super easy
